Participation | Recommended participant's age is 16-20, but until 23 years is possible. District Governors or National Representatives are requested to provide the list of participants and registration forms before 31st March on martin@poesen.be. Registration fee is 100 € per participant and it is collected by local District/Nation and then transferred to bank account of the hosting country Italy by 15th April. Each group of youngsters must be lead by an adult person (group leader), preferably by a Kiwanian who will take part of the camp organization.

Attention: Kiwanis International requires clear background checks for all adults working with youth at all KI-sponsored events i.e. 21 years old. It is the responsibility of the District or Nation to control if in their country a background check is required for adults less than 21 years.

Transport! Local transport will be organized according the provided travel details: way of transport, arrival on Monday 3th of August, departure on Saturday 8th of August.

Attention: the participants pay the travel costs to and from Italy. Of course it will be a privilege for Districts and Clubs to sponsor youth participants.
